THOUGHTS TO PONDER

JOHN CALVIN: *Christ declares that the elect always belonged to God. God therefore distinguishes them from the reprobate, not by faith, or by any merit, but by pure grace; for, while they are alienated from Him to the utmost, still He reckons them as His own in His secret purpose.*

RICHARD BAXTER: *Let DESERVED be written on the door of hell; but on the door of heaven and life, the FREE GIFT.*

JAMES MONTGOMERY BOICE: *How does one tell who are the elect of God? How do we judge who are Christians and who are not?...There is only one answer, the answer given by the Lord Jesus Christ speaking of those who were truly His disciples (in John 17: 6- 8). According to these verses, the only way to tell whether one is a Christian or not is to see whether he or she believes and continues in the words of the Lord Jesus Christ.*

RICHARD PHILLIPS: *Christians are not those who pray, "Oh high, exalted, and unknowable God, beyond our reach in majesty, aloof above the petty concerns of men," but we pray, "Our father, the Almighty, most high, all-seeing God who is with us to save us and to bless.*

MARTYN LLOYD-JONES: *You do not really keep the word of God unless you obey it. It is a word that cannot be kept only in your intellect; it has to be put in your heart and in your will also. The man who keeps the word of God is the man whose whole personality is keeping it, the man who is meditating and rejoicing in it, whose heart warms to it, and so obeys it.*

GENERATIONS OF GRACE


Principle: God sovereignly chooses whomever He wants to accomplish His purposes.

This Week: As a family, read Genesis 25:21–26; 27:1–29.


