Why do we have church services every week?

The church is not a building, but a group of God's people who have committed to follow Christ, obey His Word, and love one another. The Bible commands us to gather together to read the Scriptures, pray, sing songs that exalt God, hear God's Word preached, give money to help the church, and practice believer's baptism and communion.



Something to learn this week:

How did sin enter the world?

God created all things, and all that He made was good. When God created man, He told them how to live in a way that honors Him and brings them the greatest joy, including a command to not eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. But Satan, in the form of serpent, entered the garden and caused Eve to doubt God's goodness. She believed his lie that God's commands were not for her good, and both her and Adam disobeyed God - they sinned. Because God is just and holy, He punished this sin by cursing the serpent and removing Adam and Eve from the garden. Adam's sin now brought the curse of sin and death to all creation. But in the midst of these curses, God gave a promise to send a Redeemer who would obey Him perfectly and reverse the curse of sin and death.

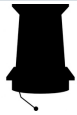
